

BYLAW ***** 2-75

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LUCKY LAKE TO REGULATE SICK LEAVE FOR EMPLOYEES' OF THE VILLAGE OF LUCKY LAKE.
SEC. 29-(S1 AND S2) AND SEC. 69-(S1) CAP 78-1970


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF LUCKY LAKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1: That after three consecutive months of employment, employees' be granted one day sick leave per month with regular rate of pay.
- 2: If the day is not used for sick leave in the current month, the days may accumulate to a maximum of 60 days of sick leave.
- 3: Any sick leave over two days must be supported by a Doctors certificate.
- 4: This Bylaw shall give benefits to Employees' at all times during or not during his regular working hours, and at any place.
- 5: An Employee shall forfeit these benefits if his employment terminates for any other reason than through illness.
- 6: This Bylaw shall be retrocative to January 1,1974 in support of Resolution #4, March 11,1974.

Read three times by unanimous vote and passed by the council of the Village of Lucky Lake in the province of Saskatchewan, this 5th day of September, 1975.
