BYLAW NO 1/2005

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A FEE TO APPEAL ASSESSMENTS ENTER DRAFT BYLAW AT THIS LOCATION

The Council of the Town/Village of LUCKY LAKE in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- Persons desiring to appeal their assessment to the Board of Revision for the Town/Village of LUCKY LAKE shall file their appeal in the form prescribed in The Urban Municipality Act, 1984.
- 2. A fee in the amount of \$\frac{100.00}{0.00}\shall accompany the form, or shall be paid to the Town/Village of \(\frac{10000}{0000}\text{VIKE} \) within 30 days of the notice of assessment being published in the Saskatchewan Gazette pursuant to subsection 249(4) of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984.
- Where the appellant is successful in whole or in part on an assessment or classification appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, the Town/Village shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant to the Town/Village.
- 4. Where an appellant fails to pay the fee pursuant to Section 2 of this bylaw, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed.
