

## Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw

Village of Lucky Lake

Bylaw No. 2015-001

### A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Village of Lucky Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) "CAO" shall mean the Chief Administrative Officer of the municipality;
  - c) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
  - d) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Lucky Lake.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with
  - a) Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw and may be revised from time to time.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator or CAO to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid
  - a) At the end of the calendar year or 90 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
