Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw

Village of Lucky Lake Bylaw No. 2015-001

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Village of Lucky Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "CAO" shall mean the Chief Administrative Officer of the municipality;
 - c) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - d) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Lucky Lake.
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with
 - a) Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw and may be revised from time to time.
- 3. The Council may authorize the Administrator or CAO to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid
 - a) At the end of the calendar year or 90 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
